Background:

There are not many specifics known about Liverpool 4 Head's background. The mummified head remains wrapped in linen bandages and has broken off from the body to which it was once attached (World Museum). Just as with Liverpool Head 3, the head was at one point a part of the collection of Dr. Herman Philip and Mrs. Dora Philip in Edinburgh and was acquired by the Liverpool World Museum from Mr. William Crosfield in between 1850 and 1860 (World Museum).
